THE MINISTRY OF HIGHER EDUCATION, RESEARCH, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, THE GAMBIA

The Ministry of Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology has granted a license to operate an online university in The Gambia to the Islamic Online University in May, 2014.



DIRECTORATE OF HIGHER EDUCATION, SOMALI FEDERAL REPUBLIC

The Somali Federal Republic, Ministry of Public and Human Services through the Directorate of Education, Culture and Higher Education granted a university license and accreditation to the Islamic Online University in July, 2013.

ENROLLMENT AND FEES

The Islamic Online University is a tuition-free institution that does not charge students to take classes. Audio and video recordings of lectures and reading materials are available online free of charge along with live tutorials for every subject.

There is, however, a fixed modest semester registration fee for degree programs ranging from \$70 to \$160 based on the standard of living in the student's country of residence.

The semester enrollment opens twice a year for Spring and Fall semesters beginning in March and September; however, students can enroll anytime via the Early Enrollment feature. The semester ends with comprehensive, externally-supervised examinations in IOU approved exam centers around the world.

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ABOUT IOU

The Islamic Online University (IOU) is the brainchild of Dr. Abu Ameenah Bilal Philips, launched in 2007 from Qatar offering more than 24 short free diploma courses. By the beginning of 2015, its total registered student body has reached more than 255,000 from 228 countries around the world. IOU has the distinction of having the most diverse student body of any university in the world.

In March 2010, the IOU introduced the world's first tuition-free, online Bachelor of Arts in Islamic Studies based on a modified curriculum derived from those of the Islamic University of Madeenah, Omdurman Islamic University, Sudan, and Al-Azhar University, Cairo.

In 2014, the IOU announced four new departments: Department of Education, Department of Islamic Economics, Banking and Finance, Department of Psychology, and Department of Arabic Language and Linguistics. One year later, in 2015, IOU added two more departments: Department of Information Technology and Department of Business Administration.

The Islamic Online University aims to grant global access to quality undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate level Islamic and Islamized educational programs for students at virtually no cost. Its mission is to be a catalyst for change in the global Muslim nation in order to facilitate their contribution to the progress of human civilization.

FOUNDER

Dr. Abu Ameenah Bilal Philips is a Jamaican - Canadian Islamic scholar who converted to Islam in the early seventies. He completed a BA in Islamic studies in Madeenah, MA in Islamic Theology in Riyadh, and PhD in Islamic Theology in the University of Wales, UK.

Dr. Bilal Philips has written, translated and commented on over 50 books on various Islamic topics. He has also edited and published the Eemaan English Reading series for children in international Islamic schools.

Dr. Bilal Philips has taught Islamic Studies and Arabic in a variety of universities and has presented Islamic programs on the majority of global Islamic TV channels. He is ranked among the 500 most influential Muslims in the world for his establishment of the mega-university, the IOU.

*Students with high school diploma or higher are eligible to receive a Bachelor of Arts in Islamic Studies (BAIS) upon successful completion of the program. BAIS can be taken part time or full time, thus completed in minimum three years or maximum twelve years.

The BAIS is a blend of Sharee'ah and Da'wah courses combined with modern conventional courses designed to prepare the Islamic Studies graduate with the necessary skills to fulfill his or her role as teacher, counselor, administrator, and scholar

STREAMS OF BAIS

Students who do not possess a high school diploma or its equivalent and choose to take the Bachelor programs will receive an Advanced Diploma from the department upon completion of the entire program.

There are no minimum requirements for IOU Audit Courses. A Certificate of Attendance will be issued by the department of Islamic studies to those who successfully complete the whole course, but do not wish to take exams at IOU's supervised exam centers.

HIGHER DIPLOMA (BRIDGE TO MA)

This one-and-a-half year (three semesters) program is for students who already possess an undergraduate degree or its equivalent in other disciplines and would like to enter the Masters degree program rather than the undergraduate degree program.

It is a prerequisite bridge certificate for entering the MAIS program consisting of 16 core courses from the IOU BAIS program.
