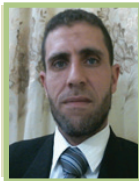

## ENROLLMENT AND FEES

## ABOUT IOU

Launched in 2007 by Dr. Abu Ameenah Bilal Philips, the International Open University (IOU) is committed to spreading beneficial knowledge across the globe. ## PROGRAMS

### Bachelors of Arts in Arabic Language and Linguistics

A 4-year program prepared by more than 50 professors and experts of the Arabic language with experience teaching Arabic to non-Arabic speaking students. This course enables students to fulfill their religious duties and become the bearers of the torch of the language of the Quran. Studying Arabic will lead to many openings for the graduates of the Arabic language in fields such as journalism, business and industry, education, finance and banking, translation and interpretation, consulting, foreign service and more.

### Intensive Arabic Program

The IAP (Intensive Arabic Program) is a two year course which combines a total of 8 subjects with concentration on Arabic reading, writing, listening and basic conversation skills. This course is open to everyone and while there are no admission prerequisites, those not fluent in reading the Arabic script are required to complete the Arabic 100 program before joining the Intensive Arabic course.

## FOUNDER

## STREAMS

### Advanced Diploma
