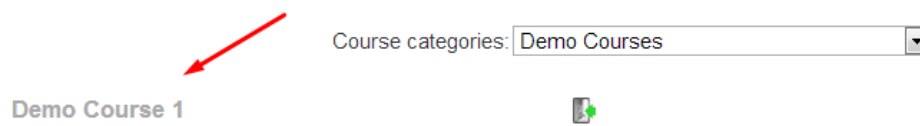



4. Now click on Demo course 1.




5. You will then be taken to the course page. Scroll down to see the modules of courses.

8. After listening to the lecture, attempt the module test.


