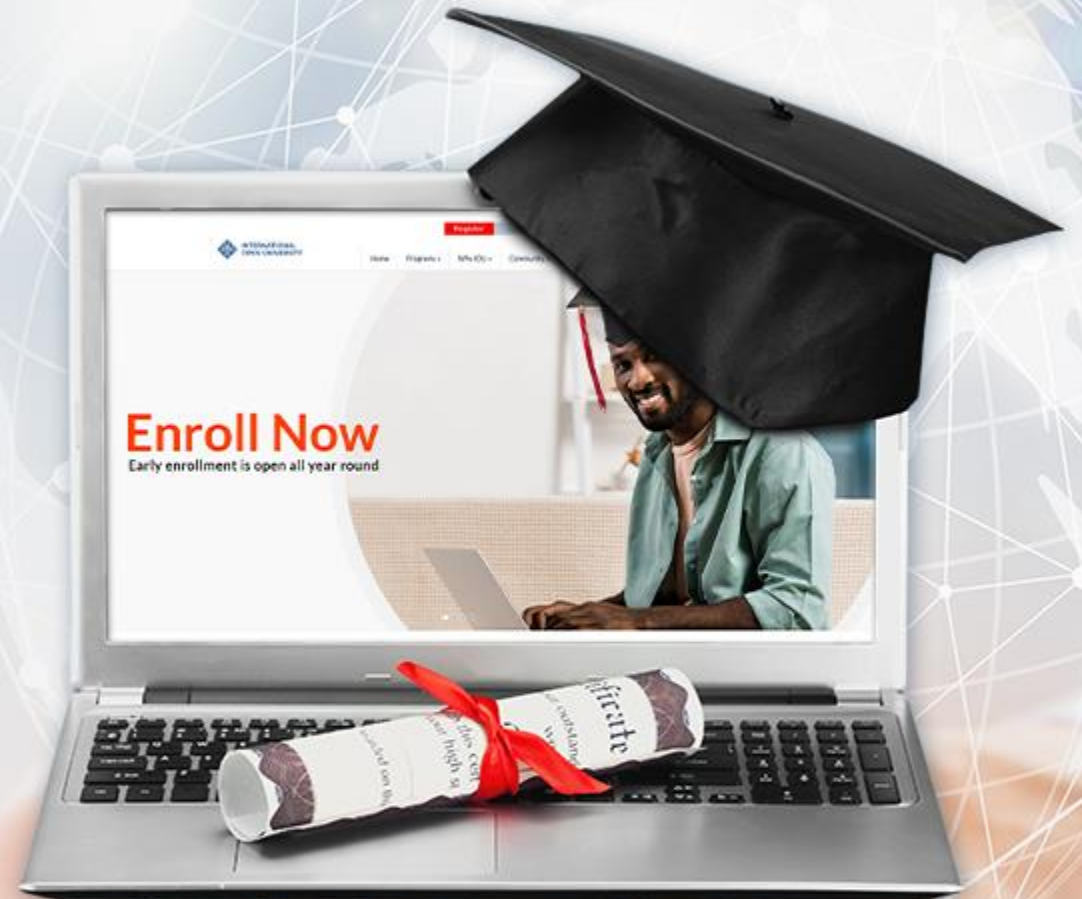

- Authored over 50 published Islamic books

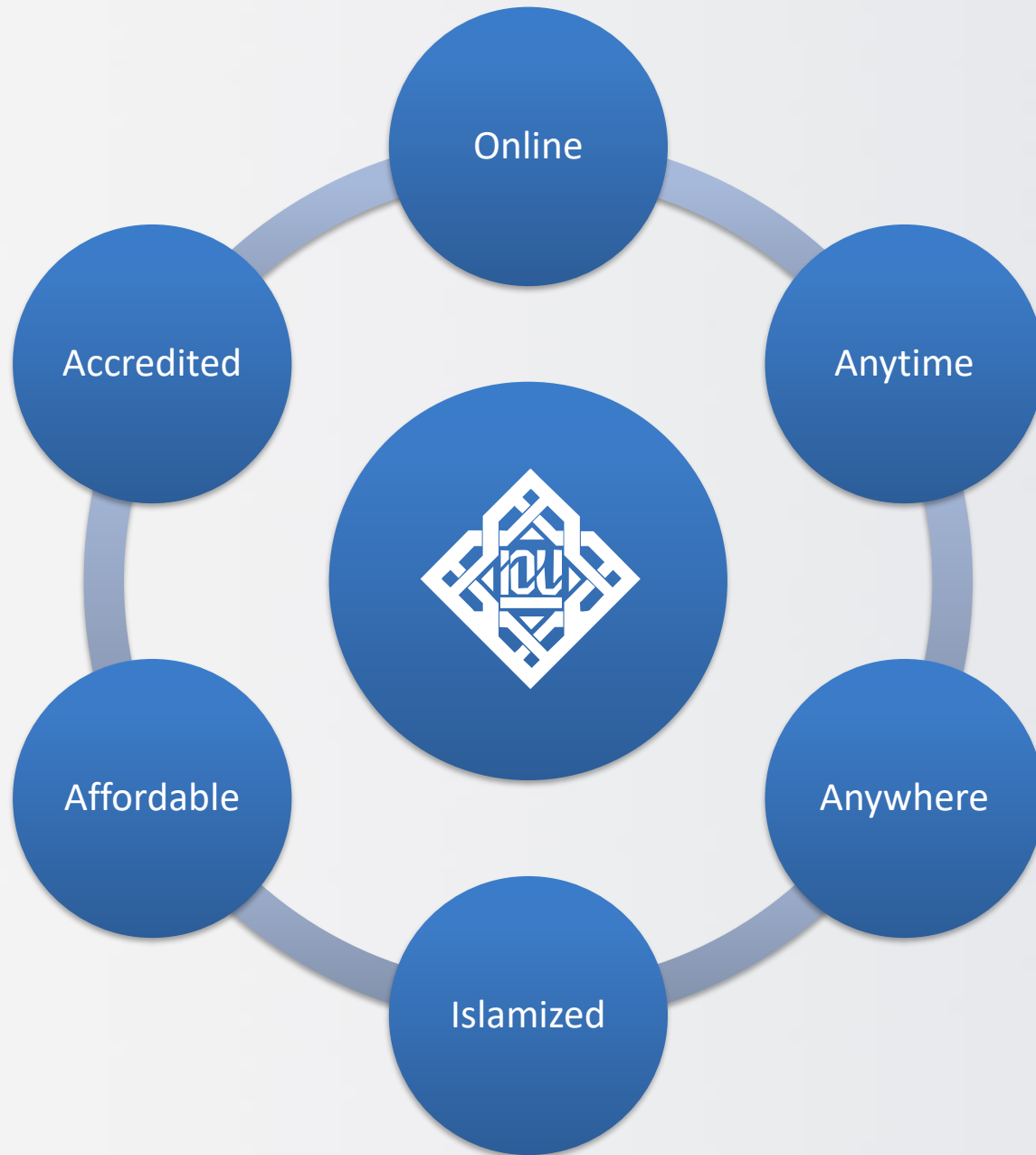

Accreditation



Ministry of Higher Education, The Gambia

The Ministry of Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology in the Republic of The Gambia granted the International Open University a license to operate an online university in 2014.



National Accreditation and Quality Assurance Authority, The Gambia

The National Accreditation and Quality Assurance Authority (NAQAA) granted the International Open University institutional and program accreditation for its Bachelor's and Master's degrees starting in 2019.



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History of the International Open University

2001

- IOU launched as the Islamic Online University and offered paid baccalaureate courses, but stopped operation in 2002.

2007

- IOU relaunched with 22 free diploma level courses and had over 1,500 registered students.

2010

- IOU expanded by launching one of the world's first online Bachelor of Arts in Islamic Studies (BAIS), and registered students for the diploma courses increased to 30,000.



History of the International Open University

2014

- Four new departments were opened which offered Bachelor's degrees in Arabic, Education, Banking & Finance, and Psychology.
- IOU established its headquarters in the Gambia and received a university license from the Ministry of Higher Education.
- IOU began offering the BAIS program in Russian.

2015

- Two new departments were opened to offer Bachelor's in Business Administration and Information Technology.
- IOU began to offer a Master's in Islamic Studies (MAIS).



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History of the International Open University

2017

- IOU began offering the BAIS program in Bahasa for Indonesians.
- The 1 Million African Scholarships (1MAS) initiative was launched to provide free Bachelor's degree scholarships to the underprivileged in Africa and its diaspora.

2019 & 2020

- The National Accreditation and Quality Assurance Authority (NAQAA) of The Gambia granted IOU institutional accreditation.
- IOU officially changed its name to the International Open University.



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History of the International Open University

2021 & 2022

- NAQAA granted program accreditation for IOU's Bachelor's degrees in Arabic, Business Administration, Banking & Finance, Psychology, Education, and Islamic Studies, as well as the Master's in Psychology.

2023

- NAQAA accredited IOU's Bachelor's degree in Information Technology, Postgraduate in Education, and Master's degrees in Arabic, Business Administration, Banking & Finance, Education and Islamic Studies.
- For the 2022-2023 academic year, 9,105 students registered.

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Islamic Studies – Bachelor of Arts (BAIS)

Degree Program

- Requirement: High School Diploma or equivalent
- Duration: Four years

Program Content

- Core courses in Sharee'ah (Islamic Law) plus Da'wah (Propagation) supplement
- Additional 5 modern core course areas: Education, Psychology, Finance, Management Information and Communications Technology (ICT)



Postgraduate Certificate in Islamic Studies

Bridge to MA (BMAIS)

- For existing Bachelor's degree holders in fields other than Islamic Studies
- Take Sharee'ah courses in Aqeedah, Fiqh, Tafseer, Seerah, Hadeeth, and Arabic
- Prerequisite for joining IOU's Masters in Islamic Studies for non-BAIS students
- Duration: One and half year



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Islamic Studies – Master of Arts (MAIS)

Degree Program

- Requirement: BA in Islamic Studies from an accredited institution or a BA in a subject other than Islamic Studies (e.g. B.Sc., B.Com.) with a BMAIS from IOU
- Options: Coursework or Research-based
- Duration: Two years

Global Qur'an Memorization Center

Has a variety of Quranic programs including those for memorization (group, one-on-one, ijaazah) and Tajweed (beginner, advanced). All programs are offered to 12+ years at affordable monthly fee and are gender segregated.



General Diploma in Islamic Studies

IOU offers over 40 courses, at a small subscription fee of as little as \$1 per month, spanning 6 levels of learning. Students may obtain a diploma upon successful completion of 24 of those courses.

It provides easy access to a multitude of professional, Islamic and modern short courses taught by highly qualified instructors from across the globe, without any educational requirements or time limits.



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Requirements for Online Learning at IOU

Studying online is challenging. Before you get started, here are some points to consider:

Language Requirements

Students are required to possess proficiency in English, as it is the primary medium of instruction. Students may be asked to take an English placement test to assess their language abilities. Students with lower scores will be encouraged to enroll in short English courses designed to enhance their language skills. Arabic programs are taught in English, but a basic level of Arabic reading is required, with the exception of the masters degree.

Time Management

Students need to allocate the necessary amount of time per week for them to complete their courses and be punctual in meeting deadlines for the module tests, assignments, and exams. IOU offers a time management course to help students.

Requirements for Online Learning at IOU

Educational Requirements

The minimum requirement for undergraduate programs is a high school diploma. Students who do not possess one, or choose not to take exams or write assignments, can opt for the Audit Course of bachelor's and master's degrees.

Exam Center Accessibility

Students are required to take exams at IOU approved exam centers, so the nearest one should be located, or a request for a closer one to be established should be made.

Computer Literacy

Students should possess basic computer skills, including the ability to use the internet for research, use of a word processor, sending and receiving emails, as well as how to open, save, download and upload files.
