History - 2001 to 2010

2001

• IOU launched as the Islamic Online University and offered paid baccalaureate courses, but stopped operation in 2002.

2007

• IOU relaunched with 22 free diploma level courses and had over 1,500 registered students.

2010

 IOU expanded by launching one of the world's first online Bachelor of Arts in Islamic Studies (BAIS), and registered students for the diploma courses increased to 30,000.



History - 2011 to 2015

2014

- Four new departments were opened which offered Bachelor's degrees in Arabic, Education, Banking & Finance, and Psychology.
- IOU established its headquarters in the Gambia and received a university license from the Ministry of Higher Education.
- IOU began offering the BAIS program in Russian.

2015

- Two new departments were opened to offer Bachelor's in Business Administration and Information Technology.
- IOU began to offer a Master's in Islamic Studies (MAIS).



History - 2016 to 2020

2017

- IOU began offering the BAIS program in Bahasa for Indonesians.
- The 1 Million African Scholarships (1MAS) initiative was launched to provide free Bachelor's degree scholarships to the underprivileged in Africa and its diaspora.

2019 & 2020

- The National Accreditation and Quality Assurance Authority (NAQAA) of The Gambia granted IOU institutional accreditation.
- IOU officially changed its name to the International Open University.



History - 2021 to 2024

2021 & 2022

 NAQAA granted program accreditation for IOU's Bachelor's degrees in Arabic, Business Administration, Banking & Finance, Psychology, Education, and Islamic Studies, as well as the Master's in Psychology.

2023 & 2024

- NAQAA accredited IOU's Bachelor's degree in Information Technology, Postgraduate in Education, and Master's degrees in Arabic, Business Administration, Banking & Finance, Education and Islamic Studies.



Requirements for eLearning - Language and Time

Studying online is challenging. Before you get started, here are some points to consider:

Language Requirements

Students are required to possess proficiency in English, as it is the primary medium of instruction. Students may be asked to take an English placement test to assess their language abilities. Students with lower scores will be encouraged to enroll in short English courses designed to enhance their language skills. Arabic programs are taught in English, but a basic level of Arabic reading is required, with the exception of the master's degree.

Time Management

Students need to allocate the necessary amount of time per week for them to complete their courses and be punctual in meeting deadlines for the module tests, assignments, and exams. IOU offers a time management course to help students.

Requirements for eLearning - Education and Exams

Educational Requirements

A high school diploma that is at ISCED level 3 is needed for undergraduate programs, while different countries have different credit requirements that must be met. Students who do not possess one can opt for the Audit Course of bachelor's and master's degrees.

Examination Center Accessibility

Students are required to take exams at IOU approved exam centers, so the nearest one should be located, or a request for a closer one to be established should be made.

Computer Literacy

Students should possess basic computer skills, including the ability to use the internet for research, use of a desktop or online word processor, sending and receiving emails, as well as how to open, save, download and upload files.

Global Quran Memorization Center

GQMC offers memorization and Tajweed programs to students who are 12+ years and classes are gender segregated. Fees for memorization start at \$10 to \$50 per month, based on a student's country of residence, and for tajweed is a one-time payment of \$60 or \$100.



General Diploma in Islamic Studies

GDIS provides over 40 courses, spanning 6 levels of learning, at a small subscription fee of as little as \$1 per month. Students may obtain a diploma upon successful completion of 24 of those courses. They will also be given access to over 10 special workshops.



Ilm Institute

Provides easy access to a multitude of professional, Islamic and modern short courses taught by highly qualified instructors from across the globe, without any educational requirements or time limits. Courses cover topics including education, finance, health, parenting, and psychology.



Solace Islamic Mental Health Services

Offers online mental health services such as counseling, imam consultation, and workshops, as well as training for adults, youth and children. All of its services are provided by qualified Islamic professionals, with affordable fees starting at \$30 per session and \$15 for workshops.



IOU attempts to strengthen the capabilities of the underprivileged through the provision of quality higher education. Earning a university degree helps them create a better livelihood for themselves and their families, as well as empowers them towards the eradication of poverty in their communities. The United Nations has stated that the main difference between the first and third world is education. This is apparent with only 6% of sub-Saharan youth enrolled in higher education compared to the global average of 26%.

For this reason in 2017, IOU launched the African scholarships project with the aim of educating one million students in Africa and its diaspora. Alhamdulillaah, within 6 years and with the support of our donors, we have reached 25 countries and have offered scholarships to almost 5,000 students. We've granted scholarships across Cameroon, Egypt, Eswatini (Swaziland), Ethiopia, Fiji, Gambia, Ghana, Jamaica, Kenya, Libya, Malawi, Morocco, Mozambique, Namibia, Nigeria, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, Somalia, South Africa, Sudan, Tanzania, Trinidad and Tobago, Uganda, Zambia, and Zimbabwe.
