Masters - Research (MA ALS-R)

This two-year research-based program has been designed to give a thorough and supportive opportunity to conduct research in Arabic. It enables advanced familiarity with classical and modern Arabic literature, poetry, or Islamic religious texts.

Intensive Arabic Program (IAP)
